Minutes of a Special Meeting held on Monday 28th September 2009 at 7.30 in Elmley Castle village hall.

Apologies were received from Professor Walton

To consider

PAW/09/02102/PP and 02103/LB- Mr Burrows, Deakins Cottage, Hill Lane – Garden Room. Installation of Bathroom, WC and Porch, Carport & Garage, Window & Door Alterations & Structural Repairs. Comment to WDC, in principle the Council does not have a problem but the quality of the drawings made it very difficult to interpret the plans. The Parish Council will rely on the Conservation Officer & Listed Buildings Officer to ensure that the materials used and the design proportions are in keeping with the existing building.

Miscellaneous Correspondence

- a) WDC re Red Telephone kiosks – the agreement is with BT & is a contract for purchase of the kiosks incorporating conditions. Mr Moss said that the Parish Plan questionnaire had shown that residents were keen for them to be retained & he would prefer the Council to be in control of when the boxes eventually disappear. Following a lengthy discussion it was decided that the clerk will speak to Lynne Yapp to ascertain the position with regard to Little Comberton and will also write to BT about the lack of mobile coverage. There will be a charge for terminating the electricity supply, cost dependant on where the source of the supply. The clerk will gather further information which the Chairman will then circulate, & a decision will be reached before 31st October, the deadline for a response to WDC.
- b) Flood Alleviation – a letter had been received from Tony Jones stating that following the meeting attended by the Chairman, Mr Moss, David Lavender & Nick Haycock it had been agreed that progress could be made in line with suggestions made by Nick Haycock. The Chairman offered speak to Nick Haycock ensure that the scheme was being drawn up & to discuss his likely costs and costs incurred to date, he would also speak to Tim Lea about the proposals. It was agreed that a date would be arranged to suit Nick Haycock, when the flooding group could meet with him to further the plans. David Lavender would be invited to the flooding meeting.
- c) Letter from Mr Hickman, Church House was read & it was agreed that the suggestions made would be discussed further at the next meeting on 5th November.
- d) WDC re Standards Board Procedure, Mr Hickey proposed & Mr Moss seconded a proposition that the procedure be adopted and included in the Standing Orders of the Parish Council (attached to the minutes) all in favour
