MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING HELD ON

SATURDAY 6th FEBRUARY 2010 AT 10.45 AM

1. PAW/10/00041/PP & 00042/LB – Mr Dymoke, Sunnybrook Cottage, Hill Lane – Single Storey Extension & Associated Alterations. **The Parish Council unanimously supported this application.**
2. PAW/10/00069/LUE – Mr J Cook, New Farmhouse, Bricklehampton – Certificate of Lawfulness for existing land and buildings for storage of building materials & parking, unloading & access over existing drive. **The Parish Council had no objection to this application.**
3. PAW/10/00108/CU – Mrs Eaton, The Long House, Netherton Lane – Application to vary condition 9 of PAW/05/1244 to allow ancillary accommodation to use as holiday lets or short term lets. **The Parish Council unanimously supported this application.**
4. PAW/10/00035/PP – Mr E Eaton, Lisdon House, Bricklehampton – New Garage & Conservatory Extension. **The Parish Council were concerned that the new garage extended in front of the building line and asked where the oil tank was to be moved to. There was also comment about the fact that the conservatory was already constructed and had been built for a number of years, so that more properly, the application should have been retrospective for this element of the application. However the application was not objected to.**

Miscellaneous Correspondence

The Chairman read a letter which had been received from Haycock Associates following letters and phone calls from the Clerk. Cllr. A Mackison informed the meeting that WDC flooding engineers had offered to conduct survey work on the projected site in Hill Lane in the light of Haycock Associates being unable to support the PC. It was agreed that the Parish Council Flood Working Group would meet to agree the way forward with the WDC flood engineers and to commission the other aspects of the scheme. **Action Chairman/Clerk to arrange.**
